


## Extracted from the Swamp Fox Contest Group newsletter by Kevan Nason, N4XL

 An unfused 6 port Anderson Power Pole distribution panel is available from MFJ for around \$80. Ran across an 8 port unit on Amazon with fuse protection on the input and individ-



ual output lines. There is also blown fuse indication. All for \$60. There are several units fused an unfused starting for \$32. Chinese made of course.

• I had a 40/80 elevated vertical. The counterpoise wires were of two different lengths for the two bands. It was damaged and I replaced the vertical itself with one for 40 meters only. I left the wires alone figuring since the others weren't resonant they wouldn't have any effect on the resonant frequency. When I checked the SWR I found it resonant near 6350 KHz. The vertical was vintage 1970's and no manual is available. Being that far off I thought perhaps the vertical was commercial or military and wasn't for the Ham bands. Thinking a bit more I considered the 80 meter counterpoise wires. It would be similar to an OCF dipole which has one leg long and the other short. Huh. I removed the 80 meter wires so only the 40 meter wires were connected. Resonance now happens at 7150. I do both CW and SSB contests so I can't ask for more than that. It's a vertical though so the SWR at resonance is near 2:1. Someday I'll build a matching network, but for now I have a base mounted autotuner to take care of that. There is only a short coax feed between the tuner and antenna so coax loss due to higher SWR is minimal.
